The Magnolia Council of Deliberation Ceremonial Opening will be on **Friday, April 12, 2024**, **at 5 p.m**., Masonic Dress with cap and jewel will be required for the Ceremonial Opening for all Sublime Princes of the Royal Secret and crown and jewel for all Grand Inspectors General. Illustrious Sirs who are in possession are allowed to wear the Joseph B. Henderson Gold Blazers with a white shirt, black bow tie, black pants, and black shoes with crowns. The required attire for **Saturday, April 13, 2024**, Sublime Princes and Illustrious Sirs will be a black suit/white shirt, black bow tie, white gloves, and the **required** black robes for a Grand Inspector General along with their Cap or Crown with proper jewel. All Loyal Ladies are required to wear their Golden Circle Cap, Cape, and White dress with the required length.

All Consistories are required to have the names of Candidates who will receive the degrees of Grand Inspector Inquisitor Commander, 31°, and Sublime Prince of the Royal Secret, 32° information sent to the Grand Secretary KSA, Ill. Patrick Morgan., 33°, by March 15, 2024. All Candidates will be required to be at the Masonic Temple on Friday, April 12, 2024, at 1 p.m., Dressed Masonically. The Magnolia State Grand Assembly will be conducting degree work on Friday, April 12, 2024, at 3:00 p.m. for a fee of \$100.00.

Each Consistory is also responsible for submitting their per capita tax of **\$25.00** for each member on roll by **March 1, 2024**.

The pre-registration fee for all attendees shall be <u>\$50.00</u> and onsite registration is <u>\$75.00</u>. The registration fee will include a luncheon and banquet ticket. Additional banquet tickets can be purchased for a fee of **\$30.00** and must be purchased by **March 15, 2024**. <u>There will be no</u> <u>banquet tickets sold on-site</u>.
